



PROGRESS PRIDE SCARF

This How-to takes you step by step how to create your own crochet Progress Pride scarf. It shows you the pattern used for the design, with the options to pick the weight and customise the length of your scarf.

The original scarf was made by using 4 strands of DK together and a size 9mm Hook. This How-to demonstrates the stitch pattern with 1 strand of DK. For a chunky yet more wearable scarf I suggest 3 strands on a 7 or 8mm hook.

To create your scarf with 3 strands, I recommend 3 Ball of 100g DK for the Rainbow Colours and 2 Balls of 100g DK for the other Colours used- You can take the end from the inner and outer of the balls to get 2 ends from one ball.

KEY: UK Pattern Terms

CH = Chain

Sp = Space

St = Stitch

SlSt = Slip Stitch

DC = Double Crochet

TR= Treble

TR2TOG = Treble 2 Together

(..)= Worked into the same stitch/gap

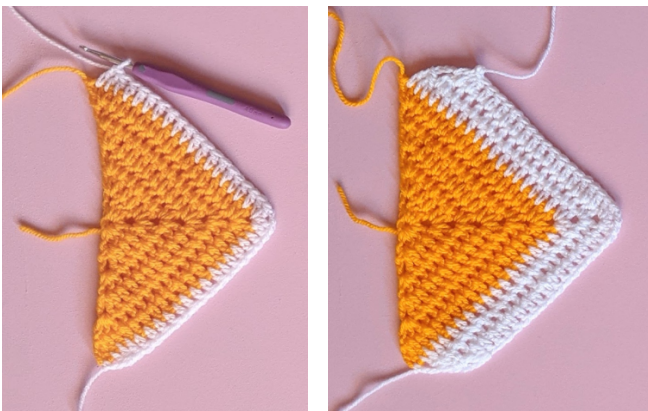
STEP 1- WORKING THE WIDTH OF THE SCARF, STARTING IN YELLOW
FOUNDATION LOOP: CH4, SlSt into first CH to create loop

ROW 1: CH4, working into the loop (TR3, CH2, TR3, CH1, TR1), turn

ROW 2: CH3, working between stitches (TR2), TR2, (TR2, CH2, TR2) into corner CH Sp, TR2, (TR3) into last space, turn (7TR on 1 edge)

ROW 3: CH3, working between stitches (TR2), TR between each stitch till corner CH Sp, (TR2, CH2, TR2) into corner CH Sp, TR between each stitch till last sp, (TR3) into last space, turn

ROW 4-6: Repeat row 3, until you have 19 TRs along one edge of triangle (38TR in total), Fasten off



STEP 2- WORKING IN WHITE FOR 3 ROWS BETWEEN STITCHES

Join in white between 1st and 2nd TR

ROW 7-9: CH3, TR2TOG over the next 2 Sts, TR15, (TR2, CH2, TR2) into corner CH Sp, TR15, TR2TOG over the next 2 Sts, TR1, turn. *Fasten off at end of Row 9*



STEP 3-

ROWS 10-12: Repeat Step 2, working in Pink

ROWS 13-15: Repeat Step 2, working in Blue

ROWS 16-18: Repeat Step 2, working in Brown

ROWS 19-21: Repeat Step 2, working in Black



STEP 4- WORKING THE LENGTH OF THE SCARF.

SCARF LENGTH FOUNDATION ROW: Working in Yellow, Join in at the Central corner CH Sp.

This Step creates the length of your scarf, loosely CH the amount of stitches to the length you desire.



YELLOW LENGTH ROW 1: CH3, working into the 3rd ST from hook TR, TR into each chain until last ST. (3TR) into the final ST where you originally joined the scarf Foundation. To anchor row, attach to ROW 21, miss 2 and DC into the space



YELLOW LENGTH ROW 2: CH3, miss 2 (ROW21), DC anchor between stitches, Turn, (TR2) into first space, TR between each ST till end, Turn

YELLOW LENGTH ROW 3: CH3, TR between each ST till last ST, (TR2), TR into the top of the last TR, anchor row- miss 2 and DC into the space, Fasten Off



STEP 5-

ORANGE ROW 1: Working in Orange, turn work and Join in 2 STs above fasten off with a DC. TR into the top of the first TR. TR between each ST till end.



ORANGE ROW 2: CH3, turn, TR in-between each ST until last SP, (TR2), TR into the top of the last TR, anchor row, miss 2 and DC into the space, Fasten Off

ORANGE ROW 3: CH3, miss 2 (ROW21), DC anchor between stitches, Turn, (TR2) into first space, TR between each ST till end, Fasten off



STEP 6-

Repeat Step 5 working in Red

**STEP 7-**

GREEN ROW 1: Working the second side of the scarf. Join in Green 2 STs above the central corner CH SP with a DC. (TR 3) into the same ST as the increase below/ first ST. Working over the original Foundation CH, TR between each ST till end.



GREEN ROW 2: CH3, turn, TR in-between each ST until last SP, (TR2), TR into the top of the last TR, anchor row, miss 2 and DC into the space, Fasten Off

GREEN ROW 3: CH3, miss 2 (ROW21), DC anchor between stitches, Turn, (TR2) into first space, TR between each ST till end, Fasten off

**STEP 8-**

Repeat Step 5 working in Blue

**STEP 9-**

Repeat Step 5 working in Purple

**STEP 10-**

ROW 1: To neaten off the start of scarf and triangle edge join in yellow with a DC over the side of the Treble Post, CH2, TR2 into the same SP, ((TR2) over the side of the next TR post) X5, TR1 into the foundation Loop, ((TR2) over the side of the next TR post) X5, (TR3) into the final Sp.

ROW 2: CH3, turn, TR between each ST till end. Fasten Off

**STEP 11-**

Create purple ring- Make 2- 1 for each side of scarf

FOUNDATION LOOP: Working in Purple CH20, SlSt into first CH to make Loop

ROUND 1: CH1, DC29 around Foundation CH into the Loop, SlSt into the first CH to complete round, Fasten Off

FINISHING: Place Circles on both sides in the Yellow Triangle to finish the intersex section of the Pride Flag. Using 1 strand of Purple yarn sew circles in place by sewing them together sandwiching the main body of the scarf in-between.

SEW IN ENDS**STEP 12-**

FRINGE: To add fringe

- Cut strands of your left over yarn, just over twice the length you wish the fringe to hang.
- Divide up and fold in half
- Poke through folded end over the scarfs end stitches and pull through tails to secure fringe
- Repeat as desired
